To be heavy laden means to be overburdened by ceremony or spiritual anxiety.

EFFECTIVE STEWARDSHIP IN GOD'S KINGDOM

which every other system hangs.

The body of Christ or His Church or Ministry on earth, regardless of the name you attach to it, or how many are in it, is established on Christ Jesus, “the way, the truth, and the life” (John 14:6); who is also “the chief cornerstone” (Ephesians 2:20). Irrespective of who you are or where you are established, you need to grasp the essence of this message so you can maximize it for your benefit.

The word, “steward” or “stewardship” is commonplace. You find it used in the circular and business world to refer to people specifically assigned to oversee certain aspects of the organisation’s projects. On a more significant note we need to have a Biblically-based understanding of this word in relation to the kingdom of God on earth, made up of the body of believers worldwide who constitute His Church. Scripture reveals that the Church of the living God, of which we are a part, is the pillar and ground of the truth (1 Timothy 3:15), and thus should serve as the foundation and structure upon

A look at the three key words in this phrase—Effective, Stewardship, and God’s Kingdom is necessary for our understanding of this subject matter. In the Greek lexicon, the word “effective” is used to denote a strong working force or operation. It also means to be active, efficient, effectual, fervent, mighty in, show forth self, to work effectually in, and to be powerful. On the other hand, the word “stewardship” is used to refer to the administration of a household or estate (particularly a religious one), an economy or dispensation. Now the person who carries out these

duties is called a steward. In some Bible translations the word steward is translated as servant. Examples include references to the steward of Joseph's house (Genesis 43:19) and Cornelius' household servants (Acts 10:7). Thus a steward can be described as a house manager, overseer, i.e. an employee in that capacity. This title applies to a husband in a family set up (see Ephesians 5:22-33), who is designated by God to be the manager of his household, lovingly taking care of his wife and children.

Sadly, this is sometimes not the case. Figuratively, the same title, "steward", applies also to a preacher of the gospel. I am not talking about the five-fold ministry gifts, although that is correct as designed by God. Hence we read, "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ" (Ephesians 4:11-13). But I am also saying that the title applies to every child of God since we have all been given the great commission to take the gospel to the whole world (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16).

As believers, we are God's stewards.

We are expected to be faithful to the task of fulfilling the Great Commission given to us by God and also fulfilling all other respective roles or tasks He gives us relative to our callings and destinies. Hence Paul said, "Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful" (1 Corinthians 4:1-2).

Let me reiterate that we are all stewards, i.e. servants in the house of God or in the church of Jesus Christ—with defined and specific roles that have been assigned to us by God—roles which we must discover and effectively fulfil. Having established the fact that we are all stewards or servants appointed by God, it naturally follows that our sphere of operation will first of all be in God's kingdom. In other words, the domain or sphere of authority where this managerial duty is to be carried out is totally God-defined, in His kingdom, and from His kingdom.

Interestingly, the Bible defines the kingdom of God in terms of place (topographical) and system (methodological). In terms of place, it refers to God's rule being manifested on earth. Hence, we can understand why Jesus in the popular 'Our Lord's Prayer' said, "Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be

done On earth as it is in heaven” (Matthew 6:9). In spite of the anarchy and upheavals in different parts of the world today which tend to undermine the essence of this prophetic word, we know without a doubt that this word will still be fulfilled as echoed in the Book of Revelation 11:15, “The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever.”

As a system or methodology, the kingdom of God refers to God’s ways of doing things, which is diametrically opposed to the world’s ways. Scripture admonishes us to seek God’s kingdom and righteousness (Matthew 6:33). This means that we are to preoccupy ourselves with God’s righteous, holy, loving, just, and faithful ways of doing things. Doing so will

produce the best results loaded with blessings both for us and for others. Another aspect of the result of doing things God’s way is seen in the fruit that will be born. Such fruit will have eternal value (John 15:16; Philippians 4:17), will characterize God’s nature (James 3:18; Galatians 5:22-23).

Furthermore, the Bible tells us that the “kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit” (Romans 14:17).

The sum total of all I have been saying is that, as God’s children and servants, we have a duty or mandate placed on us by God to render to Him a consistent, sincere, integral, purposeful, qualitative, committed, and productive service on earth—a service that is executed in strict accordance with God’s approved ways—in righteousness, holiness,

wisdom, purity, love, joy, and steadfastness. Thus, in my own view we can define effective stewardship as the act of being vigilant and watchful, steadfast, just, diligent, committed to carrying out God’s assigned task, ever mindful of the return of our Master; serving with

godly fear; sincerely and lovingly taking care of God’s business without ulterior motives; given the highest and optimum kind of service to the One who owns our lives and the work we are to do; working wisely and exercising faithfulness in our duties, aiming for God’s approval and not

man's.

A good question to ask is, **how can we become effective stewards in God's kingdom?** To answer this question we will first look at some scriptures that deal with stewardship: "... It is required in stewards that one be found faithful" (1 Corinthians 4:2); "Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants" (Luke 12:37-38).

Jesus further told His disciples: 'There was a certain rich man who had a steward, and an accusation was brought to him that this man was wasting his goods. So he called him and said to him, "What is this I hear about you? Give an account of your stewardship, for you can no longer be steward. 'Then the steward said within himself, "What shall I do? For my master is taking the stewardship away from me. I cannot dig; I am ashamed to beg. I have resolved what to do, that when I am put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses.' So he called every one of his master's debtors to him, and said to the first, "How much do you owe my master?" And he said, "A hundred measures of oil.' So he

said to him, "Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.' Then he said to another, "And how much do you owe?" So he said, "A hundred measures of wheat.' And he said to him, "Take your bill, and write eighty.' So the master commended the unjust steward because he had dealt shrewdly. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in their generation than the sons of light" (Luke 16:1-8); "Does he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I think not. So likewise you, when you have done all those things which you are commanded, say, "We are unprofitable servants. We have done what was our duty to do" (Luke 17:9-10).

In the words of the apostle Paul, "... a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict for they are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers ... whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain" (Titus 1:7-11).

Here is another text to consider: “For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. 15And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. 16Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. 17And likewise he who had received two gained two more also. 18But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord’s money.

19After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them. 20”So he who had received five talents came and brought five other talents, saying, “Lord, you delivered to me five talents; look, I have gained five more talents besides them.’ 21His lord said to him, “Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’

22He also who had received two talents came and said, “Lord, you delivered to me two talents; look, I have gained two more talents besides them.’ 23His lord said to him, “Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’

24”Then he who had received the one talent came and said, “Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. 25And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.’

26”But his lord answered and said to him, “You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed. 27So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest. 28So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents. 29”For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. 30And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’ (Matthew 25:13-30).

You can also study for your benefit the following scriptures: Galatians 6:4-10; Luke 20:9-16; 1 Timothy 3;1-15; and Luke 12:42. Notice that the scriptures cited above reveal salient features found in both an effective and ineffective steward. But first, we want to look at the qualities of an ineffective steward.

An ineffective steward is sloppy, slothful, lazy, and careless in handling his master's business. He is also proud, arrogant, wicked, hateful, doubtful, fearful, revengeful, ill motivated, and unproductive. Rather than enrich his master's business, he plunders and wastes his resources, thereby subtracting from him. He is a slanderer and a hypocrite, a misrepresentation of the heavenly kingdom.

An ineffective steward is sloppy, slothful, lazy, and careless in handling his master's business. He is also proud, arrogant, wicked, hateful, doubtful, fearful, revengeful, ill motivated, and unproductive. Rather than enrich his master's business, he plunders and wastes his resources, thereby subtracting from him. He is a slanderer and a hypocrite, a misrepresentation of the heavenly kingdom.

At a quick glance we can identify these qualities in the Matthew 25 account of the servant with the one talent, who spitefully hid his master's talent on the ground rather than do business with it on the pretext that he was fearful to invest in a master whom he considered 'hard.' This kind of servant is detrimental to the master's vision, and so are many of God's children today who fail to render to God the kind of service He requires of them. And now **a few tips to help you know how to identify ineffective stewardship in the kingdom of God:** Failure to spend quality time to study the word of God daily so as to get well acquainted with His plans and ways of doing things coupled with failure to obey the word of God in its totality make one ignorant and unable to boldly do God's bidding. By so doing, we deplete God's resources through our ignorance and disobedient actions.

Inability to develop a consistent and vibrant prayer lifestyle limits you from receiving the vital grace gifts you need that will empower you to serve God as He desires. Also included is failing to pay your tithes accurately, regularly, consistently, and as a matter of priority over all other expenditure and bills. Failure to give willingly, cheerfully, and generously of your finances and resources to help advance the kingdom of God; failure to fulfil the vows or promises

you made to God, or His kingdom work, or to people thereby depicting a lack of integrity; keeping away from regular and consistent fellowship in church and other anointed Christian meetings, even when scripture warns us not to forsake “the assembling of ourselves together” (Hebrews 10:25).

Also, not serving faithfully in the kingdom of God; working in deceit and craftiness, serving God with the wrong motive to win man’s approval and not God’s; seeking selfish gain rather than the welfare of others and God’s kingdom etc. Some of these qualities are clearly cited as taboos which anybody occupying any office in God’s kingdom must abstain from.

Now let’s go back and look at the text from Titus 1:7-11 cited among the scriptures on stewardship earlier on. Other pertinent marks of ineffective stewardship include causing strife and dissension as well as walking in anger, unforgiveness, bitterness, etc.

As a matter of fact, the word of God admonishes us as God’s stewards, not to “quarrel, but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his

will” (2 Timothy 2:24-26).

May I ask? Do you in any way identify any of the qualities mentioned in your life or in your service toward God? If you do, then you need to make an immediate decision to repent and change your ways. Learn a lesson from the shrewd steward we read about in the story in Luke 16:1-8, who woke up from slumber when he was asked to give an account of his stewardship, and made one quick decision which eventually benefited him, his master, and their debtors too.

Aim in every way to be **an effective steward**. Who is an effective steward? **An effective steward is someone whose primary aim is to make God rich at all times—in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity, and in the amount of good and qualitative fruit you bear in His kingdom** (see 1 Timothy 4:12; John 15:16).

Do your best to advance God’s vision on earth so as to bring Him profit, evidenced in the salvation of souls, equipping of believers, and the ultimate expansion of God’s kingdom on earth. This you can accomplish by taking time to seek His face to know what He desires, what He wants done, how He wants you to do it, and when. Don’t be like those who procrastinate even after they have known what God wants them to do.

As an effective steward, you seek to know what God does not want in His kingdom, so you avoid doing it. Like the stewards with the five and two talents respectively, who were praised by their master in the Matthew 25:14-23 account you read earlier on, you need to be consistent, judicious, and committed in your duty, giving no room for laxity. This way, you will not be afraid of your Master's sudden visit to check on you.

Also, an effective steward studies his master closely and fashions his life after his. This means that we are strictly to fashion our lives after our model and hero, the Lord Jesus Christ. He exemplified this fact in His ministry. He also taught us to do so when He said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, 'the Son can do nothing of Himself, but that which He sees His Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner'" (John 5:19). The apostle Paul echoing the same thought commanded us to look to Jesus, "the Author and Finisher of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2). We need to look at Jesus because He is the One who has come to reveal the Father to us and in whose image we are being transformed day by day (2 Corinthians 3:18).

I believe from our discussion so far that we need to critically examine our lives to see where we need

to make the necessary and urgent adjustments. Like the shrewd steward who eventually received his master's commendation, it is high time we awoke from slumber and honestly get busy and committed in every possible way to effectuate God's vision of harvesting of lost souls worldwide and the equipping of believers for the work of the ministry. Our goal should be to see God's kingdom established on earth as it is in heaven.

Arise, therefore, and shake off the dust off your feet and begin to put to active use those gifts, talents, and resources God has given you to enrich His kingdom on earth. Don't procrastinate. Get up and do something worthwhile for God before it is too late. And if you are already serving as an effective steward, well done! Keep at it, and don't stagnate or draw back. Take heed to follow our Lord Jesus' footsteps: "I will work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work" (John 9:4).

Also, do not forget the apostle Paul's injunction: "See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be unwise but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not be drunk with wine in which is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and

spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to one another in the fear of God” (Ephesians 5:15-21).

Well, there you go! You have all it takes to be an effective steward in God’s kingdom. The choice is yours. You chose to become one and faithfully do so, and watch God overwhelm you with His blessings. In addition, He will also commend you with this priceless accolade, “Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord” (Matthew 25:21). Hallelujah!

THE VICTORY OF FAITH

No matter what battle or struggles you may be going through at the moment, I want to remind you that you have the victory—whether it is a battle over sin or the flesh, over sickness, addictions, financial, marital, or any other battle, you are victorious. The All Nations English Dictionary defines victory as “an act of winning or state of having won a battle or any kind of struggle.” The same dictionary defines a victor as “the winner in a battle, race, game or other contest

or struggle.” The Bible tells us

We are running a race (Hebrews 12:1-2) and that we are soldiers engaged in warfare (2 Timothy 2:3-4; 2 Corinthians 10:3-6). The good news the Bible tells us is that we are victors and not victims, we are winners not losers. But before one becomes a winner or victor, you must overcome the enemy. To overcome means to defeat or conquer. The Encyclopaedia Britannica 2004 defines the word overcome as “to get the better of: surmount, overcome difficulties; to overwhelm; to gain the superiority; to win.”

Since the Bible tells us that we are victors and winners, it means we have overcome the enemy. This is summed up in 1 John 5: 4-5: *“For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the*

world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?" Hallelujah! We have overcome the world, and all that is influenced by the devil.

The reason we have overcome the world is because we are born of God. If you are born again, then you are born of God. Jesus made it clear in John chapter 3 that there is a natural birth and a spiritual birth. The spiritual birth occurred when we believed that Jesus is the Son of God and confessed Him as Lord and Saviour. This brought us into the family and kingdom of God. But also more importantly, it brought us into union with God and into a covenant relationship with Him. By this union and covenant, everything God has becomes ours — His wisdom, strength, power, riches, glory, honour, etc. are now ours because we believe in His Son Jesus Christ. His victory also becomes ours because Jesus defeated the devil so that we also can walk in victory: “[God] disarmed the principalities and powers that were ranged against us and made a bold display and public example of them, in triumphing over them in Him and in it [the cross]” (Colossians 2:15,

AMP).

Jesus went to the cross and triumphed over the devil so that we can live in victory over the devil and the world. The key to the victory you and I want to experience in any battle or struggle is to have faith—that is, to believe that Jesus is the Son of God and that we have everything we need in Him. If you trust in your own abilities or that of a relative or friend, you are bound to fail. But when our trust, confidence and dependence is on Christ, we

experience the same victory He experienced when He went to the cross and was put in the grave, “... his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up ...” (Acts 2:31-32). In every trial, battle, warfare, struggle, we must remember that we have a union with God through Christ Jesus and God has a covenant with us which He will not break.

People who trusted God under the Old Covenant were never defeated by their enemies (except when they were in sin), as long as they trusted Him.

For example, when the Philistines came against the Israelites and a giant called Goliath was boasting in his physical strength, he put fear in the hearts of the Jews. But when David came on the scene of the battle, he confidently declared to the Philistine, “... Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast

defied. This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee ...” (1 Samuel 17:45-46). David trusted in God and His power and might, and the covenant God had with Israel, and God gave him victory over Goliath and the Philistines.

Another marvellous example is the victory the Lord gave the Jews

in a foreign nation when they were in captivity and the enemy wanted to destroy them. This account is in the book of Esther. After Esther was made

queen, an enemy arose in the name of Haman who wanted to destroy all the Jews from the land—just as the devil always wants to steal, kill or destroy.

To summarise, after Haman was promoted by the king, everyone was required to bow in reverence to Haman. All the king’s servants that were in the king’s palace

bowed, and revered Haman. But Mordecai (queen Esther's uncle) did not bow or reverence him. When the king's servants asked Mordecai why he did not bow, he explained it was because he was a Jew, an expression of his trust and obedience to God. When Haman found out, he set up a diabolical plan to destroy all Jews from the Persian kingdom under King Ahasuerus on a set date.

However, Esther and Mordecai and the Jews embarked on a three-day fast as an expression of the faith in God to seek His help for deliverance for the Jews. God heard their cry and answered and granted favour to Esther. This eventually led to deliverance for the Jews and promotion for Mordecai. On the contrary, the Jew's enemy was brought down and destroyed.

It's amazing what Haman's family and friends said: "And Haman told Zeresh his wife and all his friends everything that had befallen him. Then said his wise men and Zeresh his wife unto him, If Mordecai be of the seed of the Jews, before whom thou hast begun to fall, thou shalt not prevail against him, but shalt surely fall before him"

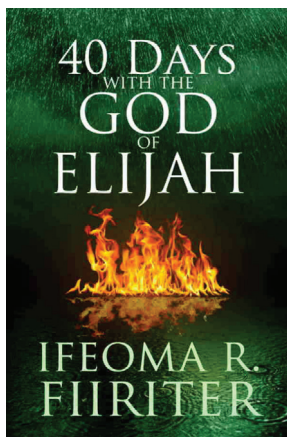
(Esther 6:13). They declared in effect that the Jew could not be defeated or overcome because they knew the Jews had a covenant with God. And the Jews indeed had the victory.

You and I are under a better covenant with better promises (Hebrews 8:6). We may not be natural Jews but as born again believers we have been spiritually grafted into the family of God, and now descendants of Abraham by faith, and joint heirs with Christ: "For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise" (Galatians 3:26-29).

As John the apostle said, the person who overcomes the world is the one who is born of God. We are not only born of God but we are heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ Jesus (Romans 8:17). Christ in us makes all the difference. He gives us the victory: "But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory

through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Corinthians 15:57).

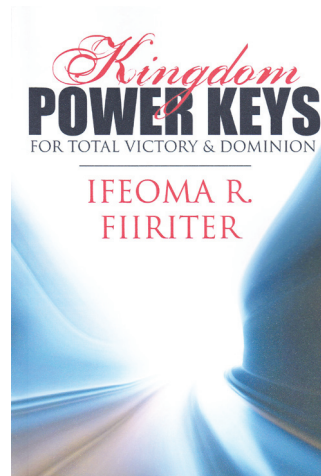
It does not matter the size, volume, power, or the duration of the battle or circumstance facing you. Christ in you is greater than that situation and God has already given you victory over that situation; “Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us” (Rom. 8:37). Hold on to God in faith. Trust in His unchanging and unfailing word. Fill your heart with His promises for your life, and with your mouth continue to declare these promises until your victory comes. Also believe in God’s power and might. Believe that power is working on your behalf to give you victory now and always: “and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith” (1 John 5:4).

EXERCISING THE MIGHTY WEAPON OF PRAISE

by Grace Edwards



Praise is one of the mighty weapons of warfare God has given us to empower us to effectively stand against the Devil's attacks or schemes so as to walk in continual victory. Praise is described in the Oxford Dictionary 2015 (published by Oxford University Press), as expressing warm approval or admiration of someone or something. This can be shown when we celebrate someone for an achievement they made or when we commend to others the value or usefulness of a product. Praise can be described as expressing one's respect and gratitude towards (a deity), especially in song or the expression of respect and gratitude

as an act of worship, and this is what I will be focusing on in this article.

The Bible shows us that we are created to praise and worship God, "the people I formed for myself that they may proclaim my praise." (Isaiah 43 v. 21). In the Book of First Peter 2 verses nine to ten, it says "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light." Being armed with this knowledge should empower us every day to praise God with every fibre of our beings. This is because He alone made us, formed us, and called us into His wonderful light by the power of the blood of Jesus, even when we went astray, and were lost in sin's miry clay. God has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in Whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins through His blood (Colossians 1 v. 13).

How and why do we praise God you may ask? We can praise God with our

mouths and lives for who He is, what He has done in our lives already or for what we believe He will do for us in the future. Thus scripture declares, “I will exalt you, my God the king; I will praise your name forever and ever. Every day I will praise you and extol your name forever and ever. Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom. One generation will commend your works to another; they will tell of your mighty acts. They will speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty, and meditate on your wonderful works. They will tell of the power of your awesome works, and I will proclaim your great deeds. They will celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness” (Psalm 145: 1-7). I encourage you to read the entire Psalm to get the full benefits of it.

We can praise God with His word and in prayer as shown in the Book of Daniel chapter 9 verse 4, “I prayed to the Lord my God and confessed: Oh Lord, the great awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love with all who love him and obey his commands.” We can also praise God in song, dance, giving of our tithes and offerings and obedience to His word as it is shown in the following scriptures. “How good it is to sing praises, how pleasant and fitting to praise him ... Sing to the Lord with thanksgiving; make music to our God

on the harp” Psalm 147 vs 1, 7); “Let them praise His name with dancing and make music to Him with the tambourine and harp” (Psalm 149: 3); “Praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand. Then Abraham gave a tenth of everything” (Genesis 14:19-20); “Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High, and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will always honor me” (Psalm 50: 14-15).

Thus we should never neglect bringing our tithes or offerings to the house of God as this is very much a part of our giving of praise and honour to God. Having said that, it is vital you allow the Lord to direct you to a church that is truly following the teachings of Jesus Christ and the leading of the Holy Spirit.

We cannot praise God when we are in sin or walking in continual disobedience to God and His word, and expect Him to receive our praise and worship. As shown in the Book of Samuel, “... Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams” (1 Samuel 15:22).

It is important we check ourselves continually, using the word of God

as our guide. We should repent of every known or unknown sin and allow the Holy Spirit to guide us to walk daily in obedience to God. I recommend you pray **Apostle Ifeoma Fiiriter's Prayer Capsule 2—Prayer For Personal Revival** in her book, **“Your Prophetic Breakthrough Prayer Capsules for Dominion.”** This prayer is very good in ensuring that we appropriately check and empty ourselves of every unclean thing that can hinder our prayers or praise unto God. I am also sure you will also find the other prophetic prayers in this book extremely useful.

When we are walking in obedience to God's word, and praise God no matter our present circumstance or situation, God is pleased to bless us and meet us at our points of need. I encourage you to read 2 Chronicles 20:1-29. In this text, we find that Jehoshaphat the king of Judah received bad news that the Moabites, Ammonites, and Meunites were coming with a vast army to make war against him. King Jehoshaphat became afraid, probably because he didn't feel that he had a capable army or enough resources to stand against this attack. Jehoshaphat, as a descendant of David, knew God, and also knew that the only one who could help Him get out of this frightening situation was the God of his father, David—the one and only true God (see Psalms 24:8). Having proclaimed a fast for all of Judah to

pray and cry out to God for help. God responded through a prophetic word that He was going to deliver them.

Interestingly, King Jehoshaphat decided to appoint men to sing praise to God. Verse 21 reads “After consulting the people, Jehoshaphat appointed men to sing to the Lord and praise him for the splendor of his holiness as they went out at the head

of the army, saying, “Give thanks to the Lord for His love endures forever.” This, to someone in war or battle, seems rather silly or foolish. Worldly reason would call for you to be on your guard, make sure you have enough weapons etc. but we know that God's wisdom is greater than any other wisdom. Verse 23 reads, “As they began to sing praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated.”

In fact, the Lord caused their enemies

to destroy one another, that by the time they came to confront the army, they found them as dead bodies. Hallelujah! In addition, God enabled them to take ownership of all the wealth and resources this dead army and people had left. So vast was the wealth transfer that it took three days to collect it all. Glory to God!

Many times when trouble comes, the Devil wants to paralyze us with fear, and then push us to make hasty decisions which could put us even in more trouble than we were in. However, if we follow Jehoshaphat's example, then we too, would experience the overwhelming victory he had over his enemies.

After fasting, praying, and hearing from the Lord, Jehoshaphat exercised the mighty weapon of praise. You notice that even after the Lord gave them victory over their enemies, they did not stop praising God. Verse 26 reads, "On the fourth day they assembled in the Valley of Beracah, where they praised the Lord. That is why it is called the valley of Beracah to this day." BERACAH means PRAISE. Hallelujah! They carried on praising God all the way back home, went to the temple in Jerusalem with harps, flutes and trumpets causing the fear of God to fall upon their enemies, and God gave King Jehoshaphat peace on every side. This means they didn't

have to worry about anyone wanting to take revenge on them concerning what had occurred or anyone wanting to attack them in the future. They had peace to enjoy the benefits of the victory God had given them.

One of the most difficult things to do is to praise God when we are hurting or going through difficult times. I believe we can all learn something from the life of the apostle Paul, especially from **Acts 16: 16- 39**. I encourage you to read the entire text. In this text we recognize that Paul and Silas were going about their business doing what God called them to do. When this girl who was demon possessed followed them for many days (see v. 18), they became fed up, and Paul decided to cast the evil spirit out of her. Doing so caused the owners of the slave girl who were benefiting from her bondage to Satan to tell lies against them, causing them to be stripped and beaten. Verse 23 of that text states, "After they had been severely flogged, they were thrown into prison and the jailer commanded to guard them very carefully."

In such a situation, Paul and Silas could have chosen to be sad, feel sorry for themselves or blame God, after all they were on God's business, and had tried everything they could to stay out of trouble. However they did not do that. Instead, they chose to pray and praise God, singing hymns.

They praised God with all their hearts in spite of their dilemma so much so that there was a violent earthquake that caused the prison doors to open and everybody's chains came loose. In this text, we see that not only did things change for them from then on, but things also changed for good for the jailer and his family. The entire household got saved (Acts 16:34).

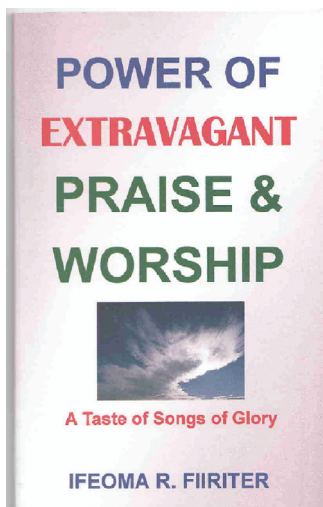

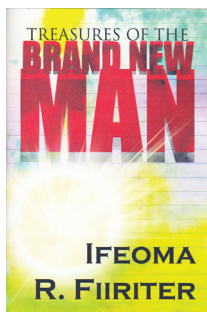

MIRACLES OF GOD

What are Miracles? They are the supernatural occurrence of the glory of God within people's lives. This can be something real to that person, such as a supernatural healing or monetary provision, etc. It could also be something supernatural, such as the ability of being able to overcome a lifetime sin. I have always believed that God is the God of miracles, and will always be so.

Four Greek words are used to describe miracles: **1.** Semeion, i.e., a sign (typically miraculous), given especially to confirm, corroborate or

authenticate.

2. Terata, "wonders" of uncertain affinity; a prodigy or omen. **3.** Dunamis, "mighty works" ability, power, strength. From the Greek 'Dunamai'; force (literally or figuratively); specially, miraculous power (usually by implication, a miracle itself) -- ability, abundance, meaning, mighty deed, worker of miracles, power, strength, violence, mighty (wonderful) work. **4.**

Erga, "works" deed, doing, labor, work. From a primary (but obsolete) ergo (to work); toil (as an effort or occupation); by implication, an act - deed, doing, labour, work.

How do Miracles happen? I have discovered that it comes from asking God for the miracle I need, giving thanks for it, and waiting for God to answer. Sometimes, there is the need to sow a seed, and perhaps even keep sowing, before reaping, or giving before receiving a miracle. We are told it is better to give than receive. Perhaps, you need to consider being more generous with others, and with your time, finances, and

other resources. Perhaps, consider continuing to pray for your miracle and stand in expectation. Expectation is the real faithful belief in God that He is able to provide what He has said He will.

There are just so many miracles within the Bible that can be discussed. Here are a couple to consider:

The miracle of the woman with the Spirit of Infirmity in Luke chapter 13 vs. 11-13:

“11 And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

12 And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.”

This woman went to the Synagogue on the Sabbath. She had been there for 18 years before the priests and holy men, yet she still had not been healed. But then, Jesus arrived, and after speaking a word of freedom to her, laid hands on her, and she was set free. Her body being bowed down was immediately set straight. Anyone can appreciate how much relief and joy she must have experienced after being set free by Jesus. Amen!

The miracle of Jesus forgiving and healing a paralyzed man in

Matthew chapter 9 vs. 1-8:

“1 Jesus stepped into a boat, crossed over and came to his own town. 2 Some men brought to him a paralyzed man, lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the man, “Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven.” At this, some of the teachers of the law said to themselves, “This fellow is blaspheming!”

4 Knowing their thoughts, Jesus said, “Why do you entertain evil thoughts in your hearts? Which is easier: to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up and walk’? 6 But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.” So he said to the paralyzed man, “Get up, take your mat and go home.” 7 Then the man got up and went home. 8 When the crowd saw this, they were filled with awe; and they praised God, who had given such authority to man.”

In this miracle, Jesus came to his home town, and this man’s friends brought him to Jesus. The friends had faith and expectation. If you expect a miracle for someone else, your faith needs to rise too. Jesus has forgiven you your sins. It was paid for long ago on the cross of Calvary. This simple fact needs to sink in to your heart and your head. Your sins are forgiven! It’s all been done. With that understanding, you reach out to God for your miracles. With expectation in the heart of the paralyzed man

and his friends, the man was released from his paralysis, and totally made whole by Jesus. It is interesting that that it was his friends and the others who witnessed the miracle and also rejoiced for him. Hallelujah!

Miracles In, And Through My Life

I have experienced many miracles in my own life. Here I will mention two that occurred when **Apostle Ifeoma** prayed for me:

“I was at the Southport Lakeside church on the 25th October 2014 to attend the **Robe Of Righteousness Ministries Int’l Healing Glory Outpouring Rally**. I went there with a lot of spiritual and physical afflictions. I felt the anointing of God as soon as I entered the venue. I slept much better that night after Apostle Ifeoma prayed for me. I only woke up at 4 a.m. I received my peace back. It was a new experience to dance for God. She prophesied that I would be an intercessor, and today, I am functioning in that role, and seeing many miracles consequently. When I went home after the meeting, I found I could praise clearer and sing better than before. I had felt the back of my jaw moving as she prayed for me.

On another occasion, I received favour from God through an agreement prayer I had with Apostle Ifeoma. On the 25th January 2015, we prayed together about the badly blocked drains I had. Thereafter, I reported a blockage because I had seen a help number on the matter. When they arrived, I asked for whatever help they could give with it. In return, I had it unblocked and cleaned for free.

Now let me share **some testimonies of miracles that I have witnessed as I prayed for other people:**

I was in Halifax, at a bridge club, when a lady opposite me was experiencing pain in her legs due

Recently, I was woken up at 5 a.m. without knowing why. I read my phone to find I had received a text from a lady saying that she had severe pain from gall stones. I offered to pray for her. I sent her texts afterwards declaring her healed and she replied that she was amazed that all the pain had gone from her body. I also declared her free from gall stones and pain. Praise God!

I felt there was a reason for me to talk to them and they invited me to come along here to this meeting (the 22nd August 2015 R.O.R.M.I. Southport Healing Glory Outpouring Rally). I have good feelings inside being here. I have got

to be honest, I came here an Atheist, where it came from I don't know but I believe I am a spiritual person.

I don't know but when you (Rev. Ifeoma) spoke to me, everything you said was spot on. I felt like I was on a roller coaster ride and my stomach was being turned inside out. I never felt like that before when someone was just talking to me. The only time I felt like that was when I was on an actual roller coaster. Right there when you spoke to me, I noticed I had no more pain in my hip. And when you prayed for me, all the pain in my body left and I don't have pain in my hip now. I am going to walk back now without my crutches.

I haven't walked properly for twelve months without these crutches. But I am healed now, O my God, I can't believe it. I can put my feet flat on the ground now. I am just thinking I couldn't do that before. Can I just say when you were praying for me, I could hear what you were saying to me. I could also hear what the person behind me (Jonathan) was saying, even though he was praying in tongues. I could understand that everything was going to be okay and my sins were forgiven. It was a very pleasant voice and I could hear it in English. I could feel warmth and heat coming from my hands and it has never happened to me before.

Can I just say thank you all. I can't believe I am walking like this. I was going for a hip operation, but now I am healed. I was prescribed the strongest pain medication you can get from a doctor, and I am on the maximum dose. Normally I take twelve tablets a day. I take two Pregabalin, eight Codeine, two Ibuprofen and one Nitrazepam to help me sleep. I have taken this medication for over three years.

there is a lot of enthusiasm and a lot of grit. I am a bookaholic and I have read the Koran two or three times, the Torah once, and different versions of the Bible. However, I just want to say that after reading all those things there was no change in my life like what has just happened here today.

Before I came here, I was in pain. I had taken my morning medication but now I am not in any pain. Look, I can



I tried to commit suicide before in 2000, obviously I wasn't successful. I went to the Boys Brigade, a Church of England establishment, a huge place, beautiful building but there was no enthusiasm. But here in your meeting,

move my legs freely now. I can put my feet flat on the ground. This is proof to me that I am healed. Honestly, the enthusiasm here is second to none. That's what it should be all about. When you (Apostle Ifeoma) speak,

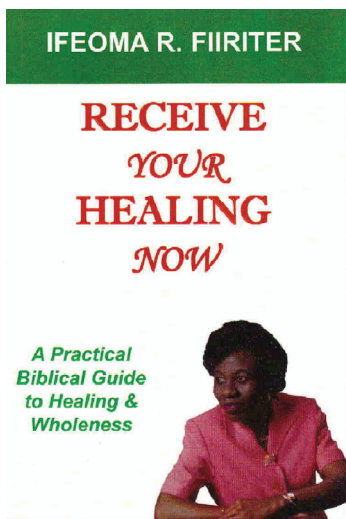
the strength that comes through your voice, it goes to other people. When something makes sense to me, I don't have to figure it out. I was due to take my medication at 3pm but I don't feel like I need a pain killer. I was sweating loads before but it has stopped.

One thing I like to do is promoting and also raising money for good causes. I would like to help you promote what you are doing. This place should be full, and it's a shame there are empty places when I know they are people waiting to come in. What you have here is so honest and so pure. You should actually have a bigger building. What I experienced here was worth me having an argument with my fiancée later on when I was trying to explain to her about what happened to me. I tried to explain what happened to me and it was too heavy for her. But she wants to come at the beginning of the meeting next time.

I struggled to praise God before because I was an Atheist but now all that is gone. Something very special has happened to me here today. I am going to come next time and bring others with me. Thank you very much." G.L., Southport.

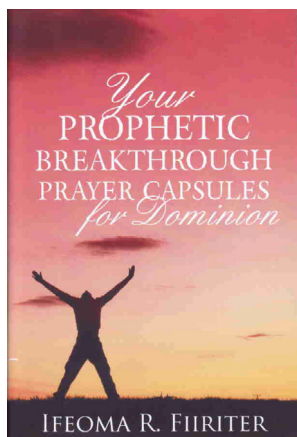

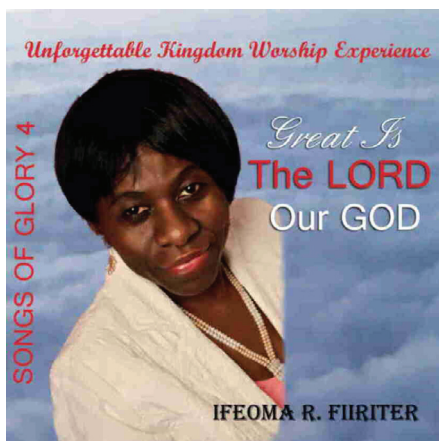

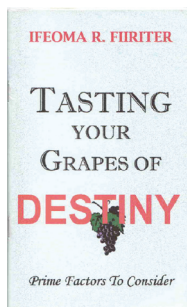

R.O.R.M.I. 2015 NIGERIAN MISSION HIGHLIGHTS & GLORIOUS REPORTS

God graciously took us to Nigeria on the 28th of May 2015 to host our Ministry’s 3-day programme in Asaba, Delta State. God also enabled us to travel safely to five main cities in Nigeria, namely, Abuja (the nation’s

Our visit was received with joy by all we met. There, it was very overwhelming meeting so many people, including new people, who have been blessed through our books, music, newsletters and other ministry resources. 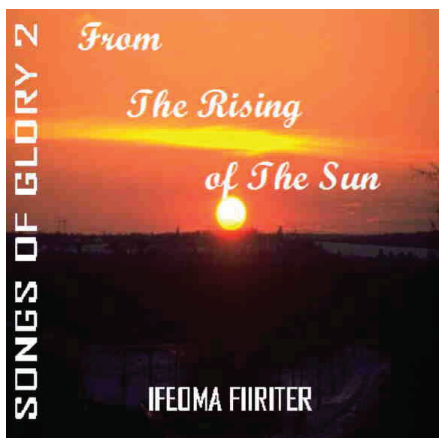

What a glorious time we had in the presence of God at this conference. God's presence came so strongly in the conference hall. It was like a fresh cool summer breeze. It blew and blew upon us all. During that time, God quickened Apostle Ifeoma to minister to His people in various ways and situations. God

He also prayed for God's people to walk in

their redemptive privileges.
